



2010 SEASON TRIALS AND INFORMATION

Dear Players, Parents and Friends,

On behalf of the Adelaide City Women's Football Club (ACWFC) Committee, I wish to welcome you and thank you for your interest in the Adelaide City Women's Football Club. ACWFC boasts a proud reputation in football throughout Australia. As a Junior/Senior Club we are also proud of our achievements and can help provide a pathway for your child to achieve her maximum football potential.

Next year the ACWFC will aim to field 3 senior teams and 7 junior teams, subject to the number and quality of players. These trials will enable us to:

1. Gauge the skills, fitness and strength.
2. Select players for their appropriate level – with a few players possibly playing above their age group.
3. Gauge how many players will be playing next season.

In the case where there are too many players attending these trials for the teams available then the Club will preferentially select players based on current and potential skills, fitness and strength.

Players will not be allowed to trial until they have supplied their contact details, including email address. This is of critical importance because in the interests of efficiency, email, in addition to the ACWFC website, will be the main method of communicating information. Players will sign an attendance sheet, indicating their arrival time at each trial before going to their coach.

There will be no reserved places for players who do not attend at trials or indicate in advance with a valid exceptional reason to the trial co-ordinator or coach that they will be absent. Players will be assessed by the appointed coach for each team in conjunction with a panel of experienced assessors from within the Club.

To be selected players must attend all trials unless otherwise advised. The Club reserves the right (in consultation with the player and parent(s)) to move a player up to a higher age group. It is expected that all players conduct themselves with courtesy and treat each other and their coaches with respect. You will find a more detailed breakdown of the various teams, registration costs involved and administrative information on the following pages. We look forward to meeting with you throughout the trials and the coming season.

THE TEAMS

The Club will aim to field 10 ACWFC Junior/Senior teams for the 2010 season, numbers permitting. Below is a breakdown of those teams.

Under 9s

Teams in this age group will play on a smaller playing area with modified rules dictated by FFSA. Teams in this age group consist of a squad of 8 players with 5 on the field at any one time. The number of teams fielded will be determined by demand.

Under 11s

The players in this age group play the rules of FIFA, albeit slightly modified as dictated by FFSA. Teams in this age group consist of a squad of 10 players subject to any changes made by FFSA in relation to the 7-a-side ruling. The number of teams fielded will be determined by demand.

Under 13s

The players in this age group play by the rules of FIFA, albeit slightly modified as dictated by FFSA. We intend to field 2 teams in this age group. An Under 13A team and Under 13B team. Each team will have 16 players. This means we will be selecting 32 Under 13s to represent ACWFC.

Under 15s

The players in this age group play by the rules of FIFA. We intend to field 2 teams in this age group. An Under 15A team and Under 15B team. Each team will have 16 players. This means we will be selecting 32 Under 15s to represent ACWFC.

Under 17s

The players in this age group play by the rules of FIFA. There will only be one team in this age group. The team will have 16 players.

Senior Teams Divisions 2 & 3

The players in this age group play by the rules of FIFA. There will only two teams in this age group. Each team will have 16 players.

Premiers

The players in this group play by the rules of FIFA. The team will have 16 players.

TRIALS

Premier League

Trials will commence **at the ACWFC grounds, park 18 Hutt Street, Adelaide** at 6.30pm on weeknights and 11.00am on Sundays (except for Under 11 and Under 9 – 10 am on Sunday). Further trial details, including appointed coaches for each team, will be advised as soon as possible.

The respective coaches in consultation with the Coaching Co-ordinator and assessment panel will make the selection of their team.

All Division 2, Division 3, Under 17s, Under 15s & Under 13s will be informed of their successful or unsuccessful selection within 7 days of the last trial date.

All Under 11 and Under 9 players will be informed of their successful or unsuccessful selection on the last day of their team trial or by email within 7 days of the last trial date.

REGISTRATION FEES

Once notified of selection, the following procedures apply:

1. Players selected to play for the Under 11 and Under 9 teams will be required to register and pay a deposit of \$100 ON THEIR REGISTRATION DAY which will be Sunday 8th November at the ACWFC grounds between 9.30am – 11.00am.
2. Players selected for the Division 2, Division 3, Under 17, Under 15 and Under 13 teams will be required to register and pay a deposit of \$100 ON THEIR REGISTRATION DAY which will be Sunday 15th November at the ACWFC grounds between 9.30am – 11.00am.
3. Payment can be made by either cheque, made out to “Adelaide City Women’s Football Club – Juniors/Seniors” or cash. No other payment method can be accepted.

IMPORTANT

The \$100 deposit is confirmation that the player intends to play for ACWFC in the 2010 season and is not refundable. If the deposit is NOT paid on the day it is assumed that the player does not wish to play for ACWFC and her position on the team will become available to another player.

The \$100 deposit is part-payment of Club fees and FFSA registration fee. The balance is due prior to 5th March 2010. Receipts will be issued on registration day and invoices will follow as soon as possible thereafter. Expected player fees, including the kit to be provided for Season 2010 will be published as soon as possible:
