CLUB INFORMATION SHEET February 2009

Dear Players/Parents,

Welcome back, or to the Club for the first time, for an exciting new season. We hope you all enjoyed your festive period and holiday break and are now ready for a season of hard work and fun, whilst developing your education and skills with your chosen sport.

Please allow us to bring you up to date with some developments and remind you of some important deadlines for previously-communicated events or activities.

New clubrooms and ground status: The plans for our new clubrooms have been approved and we are presently organising funding so we can commence building as soon as possible. We have every reason to believe that approval will not take too much longer. Those of you who drove past the ground in December would have noticed some major works going on. This was work conducted by the City Green group that will bring water from the Patawalonga to the Parklands. Unfortunately, this interrupted our ground preparation and did a significant amount of damage to the grounds and irrigation system. The irrigation system has been prepared and we are embarking upon an irrigation strategy to bring the grounds to top quality by the end of February.

Teams: We expect a total of 9 teams with the Club in 2009. This includes Premiers, Division 2, U17, U15, two U13 teams, two U11 teams and possibly an U9 team.

Registration & Fee details:

Please note that the Club has to collect GST this year. This is to facilitate the building of our Clubrooms.

All players must pay the club fee and the FFSA fee. The fees are as follows:

Premiers, Division 2 and U17 – Club Fee \$390 (including GST), FFSA fee is \$115 Senior, \$105 Concession (eg: full-time student)*, \$95 U17*

* must provide photocopy of current ID for FFSA fee discount.

U15 – Club Fee \$360 (including GST), FFSA fee is \$95

U13 – Club Fee \$360 (including GST), FFSA fee is \$700/team which equates to \$45/player

U11 - Club Fee \$300 (including GST), FFSA fee is \$400/team which equates to \$35/player

Some of you have already paid \$100 towards your Club fees. Please take that into account when finalising your balance. Payment is to be made to Franca Di Bartolo who will be available prior to trainings by cash or a cheque made out to ACWFC.

For families with more than one child playing at the Club, the fees are as follows: Oldest child, full Club fee plus GST applies; each younger child, half Club fee plus GST applies. Each player must pay the full relevant FFSA fee.

Final payment of fees is due by Friday March 20th. Should payment not be made by this time, the player will be suspended from her team and will not be able to participate in any scheduled game or training until payment is received.

THIS IS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CLUB'S NO PAY, NO PLAY POLICY

An installment plan can be organised under certain circumstances. This must be negotiated with Franca Di Bartolo the Club Coordinators ahead of the due date (March 20th, 2009).

What you get with your fees:

1 pair official Club shorts and socks and a training top/away strip. You will also be able to purchase a Club track-suit at an additional cost of approximately \$100.

NOTE: Your playing strip will be provided by the Club for each game (There will be a washing roster organised by your team manager)

Rosters:

Your team manager will organise several rosters relating to a number of duties that are important for the functioning of the Club throughout the year. This includes canteen, running the lines, erecting nets, etc... You will be advised of this around the start of the season when the rosters are available.

Training Nights:

Premier, Division 2 and U17 – Tuesday and Thursday evenings 6:20-8:00pm

U15, U13, U11, U9 – Wednesday and Friday evenings 6:20-8:00pm

NOTE: It is important that parents of junior players ensure that their children are dropped off and collected from the Coaches. This is a safety issue.

Commencement of Season: Sunday, March 29th.

Season fixtures will be provided when they become available.
